## **Monash University, Peninsula Campus**

This custom circular shelter was designed for the Peninsula Campus of Monash University as part of the recent BER funding programme.

Designed to cover the existing circular seating area, this impressive structure features hardwood timber clad steel posts and roof framing and colourbond roof sheeting spanning the entire 15m shelter.

Creating an inviting communal area of the students, this custom shelter confirms GRDC's progressive design and construct capabilities.

## Kamarooka Town Hall, Bendigo

Designed for and constructed by GRDC, this 1D2C restroom is located at Kamarooka, just outside the township of Bendigo. The restroom features:

- Colourbond roofing, internal and external cladding
- Hot dipped galvanised steel posts, roof and wall framing
- Hardwood decorative screens
- Stainless steel pans, basins and baby change tables
- Architectural hardware
- Internal and external sensor lighting
- 9000L rain tank
- Electrical and sewer connection




### **Riverdale on Plenty**

This 7m gazebo was recently installed at the new estate Riverdale on Plenty in Mernda.

Landscape Architects and developing councils will know that creating a community from scratch is a difficult task but inviting communal areas such as this one at Riverdale creates an attractive area for the new residents to get to know their neighbours.

The optional balustrading, side seating and cupola roof were added to dress up a simple gazebo design. Along

with hot dipped galvanised steel posts powdercoated in your choice of colours and colourbond roofing, this shelter can be designed to suit your needs!

This 6x6m hip roof shelter was recently installed at Barkly Gardens in Richmond. Our timber clad steel posts give our shelters the look of timber with the structural strength of steel and we use anti vandal fixings on all of our products, consequently this shelter creates valuable shaded area which is also resistant to anti social behaviour and will be structurally sound for years to come!
