**Straight Jetty**

Installation of the new fishing jetties was a joint effort between the Department of Primary Industries, City of Greater Bendigo and Go Fishing In Victoria with the support of the Friends of Kennington Reservoir and VR Fish regional members.

The platforms were funded with \$38,000 from the Victorian Recreational Fishing Grants Program using fishing licence fees; a \$56,000 capital contribution from the City of Greater Bendigo; and \$40,000 from the *Go Fishing In Victoria* Initiative.

Special thanks to GRDC's on site builders, Dick and Dallas, for their effort to complete the first jetty in time for the official opening by Mr Joe Helper MP on August 10th, 2008 during the Family Fishing Festival.
